SACRAMENTAL LIFE & LITURGICAL MINISTRIES

Altar Guild (adult) provides care for all Liturgical items, provide set up and clean up for Sunday Liturgies and flower arrangements, and take home soiled linens to clean and press. Contact: Team Co-Leaders

Acolytes (child or teen) or Altar Servers assist the priest in the celebration at Sunday Liturgies, and other liturgies. Contact: Peter Demaree

Collection Counters (adult) help count donations of Treasure following 10:30 am Sunday Liturgy. Contact: Susan Douffas

Lay Eucharistic Ministers (Confirmed adult) assist with the distribution of Holy Communion at Sunday Liturgies, and other liturgies. Contact: Leader Needed

Lay Eucharistic Visitors (Confirmed adult and trained as Lay Eucharistic Minister) visit and take Holy Communion to those who are sick or homebound on Sundays. Contact: Leader Needed

Lectors (child, teen or adult) are skilled readers who proclaim God's Word at Sunday Liturgies, and other liturgies. Contact: Leader Needed

Livestream Ministers (adult) operate our livestream equipment during 10:30 am Sunday Liturgy. Contact: Tim McCormick

Music Ministers (child, teen, or adult) including adults, teens and children who enjoy singing are welcome.

— **Children's Choir (child)** sings throughout the year especially for Christmas and Easter. Contact: Kerry Rousseau

— **Choir (teen or adult)** sings throughout the year at 10:30 am Sunday Liturgy. Contact: George Fulda

— **Instrumentalists (teen or adult)** are all welcome at 10:30 am Sunday Liturgy. Contact: George Fulda

Ushers (child, teen or adult) help provide a welcoming atmosphere at Sunday Liturgies, as well as identify people for presentation of gifts, take up the collection, and direct people for communion. Contact: Leader Needed
